Call to Order: Kevin Bowman; acting Chairperson of LRC committee called the meeting to order.

Roy discussed the basic principles of the 7 Articles addressed in the bylaws. He asked each member to read over them thoroughly, and to relay any questions to him. He would submit a copy to the Town Council at the December TC meeting. They would also review, submit question etc to Roy. The Town Council would not vote to approve the bylaws until the January TC meeting.
